Directions to the Hat Party

Address: Ninepipes Center, 5390 Ninepipe Lane; Charlo, MT 59824

From Missoula and south.

Take 93 N to mile marker 40. Take left on Olsen road and proceed W on Olsen for 2 miles. Take right at first four-way intersection, proceed N for 1 mile, and then take first left. Proceed W $\frac{1}{2}$ mile — party is at first farm on right.

From Polson and north. Take 93 S to Highway 212 (blinking light) and take right. Proceed W for 2 miles to Ninepipe Rd (dike road across Ninepipe Reservoir) and take left. Proceed S for 1 mile to first right. Continue W $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, and party is at first farm on right.

From Paradise, Perma, and Plains. Take highway 200 E to highway 212 and take left. Proceed N on 212 about 14 miles to Charlo. Go through Charlo, cross railroad tracks, and proceed about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. When 212 turns left, go straight E off highway onto gravel road/Ninepipe Lane. Proceed E $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, and party is at first farm on left.

There will be signs posted on the highways and backroads. Camping space is available for trailers and tents. Hotel rooms can be reserved at Ninepipes Lodge (406-644-2588) on Highway 93 across from Ninepipe National Wildlife Refuge, Charlo, MT.
